Release & Indemnification: I hereby recognize and acknowledge that my child's participation in recreational activities may involve bodily injury and/or emotional injury to myself and/or child. In consideration of my child being permitted to participate in such events, I for myself, my child, my heirs, my executors and administrators, hereby voluntarily and knowingly release negligence based on any injury except that caused solely by the willful misconduct of Salt Lake City, that may result from my child's participation.

Refunds: Salt Lake City may withhold 25% of the refund (program registration fee) for administrative costs. All refunds may be requested in person, accompanied with a written refund request. No refunds shall be given after the first day of the program.

Collections: I agree to pay Salt Lake City Attorney's Office for collection. I understand that any account delinquent 30 days or more will be turned over to the Salt Lake City Attorney's Office for collection.

Emergency Treatment: I hereby authorize Salt Lake City program staff to act on my behalf in accordance with their best judgement in case of an emergency involving my child, and agree to assume full responsibility for all expenses, medical or otherwise, that may arise therefrom. I understand that I or my insurance company will be billed for such emergency treatment.

Transportation Permission: I hereby understand my child or ward will be released from the afore noted school to the YouthCity Program on the days previously registered for. I hereby give my permission for YouthCity personnel to transport my child or ward from the school to the program site at Fairmont Park (1040 East Sugarmont).

I hereby agree and voluntarily assume all risk, which may be associated with or result from my child's or ward's transportation to the YouthCity Program and field trips.
