Salt Lake City Kicks Off 2004-2005 After-School Program

Today, YouthCity, Salt Lake City's youth program, launched its 2004-2005 After-School Program at six locations throughout the city. YouthCity After-School collaborates with a variety of community partners to provide school-aged youth with fun, enriching activities in art, technology, sports, education and community service.

YouthCity After-School will offer programs September through May at the following locations: Central City Recreation Center, Day-Riverside Library, Fairmont Park, Glendale Middle School, Liberty Park and the Sorenson Center.

YouthCity also offers activities for teens:

- YouthCity Employment sponsors job fairs and provides job training, skills and a professional mentoring program;
- YouthCity Government is a leadership training program that involves high school students in city and state government, community youth issues and service projects.

YouthCity's Global Artways arts education program will continue to offer public classes, sponsor public events, and administer the Kennedy Center Imagination Celebration™ of Salt Lake City, an ongoing arts education festival.
